## AOI's Urgent Financial Need

### 1. A note from our Board of Directors

Help!!!! Because of the "drying up" of some major grants (\$5000) our funds are running very low. Of course we are still in need of items (in good condition) that we can deliver to the impoverished and needy in the poorest section of our state, but unless we have the funds to pay for fuel (you know how expensive it is!) we won't be able to do so. We must also make insurance pay-

ments on our two trucks (24-footer—"Blue"; 14-footer—"Bessie"), care for their maintenance and upkeep, and provide monthly payments to the finance company so that one day they will be ours. So, dear friends and supporters, we desperately need your financial assistance. If each of you could give, if possible, at least a \$25 donation, it would ease the financial crunch. We need

prayers, prayers, prayers (it goes without saying), gently used goods, help in loading, etc., but currently our major need is...money. ## The Good News...

- *Celebrity Service:* AOI raised over \$900 at the Celebrity Server Night on April 19. Thank you to all who supported us.
- *AOI wins award:* On July 11 AOI received the 2007 Governor's Service Award given to West Virginian organizations "who exemplify the spirit of community service and volunteerism." Included with this award was a \$500 donation from Volunteer WV.
- *"Dollar-a-Monthers":* 24 individuals have responded generously to our \$1-a-month challenge by donating \$299. Others are always welcome to join them.
- *NIP:* AOI raised over \$3,000 through tax credits granted through the state Neighborhood Improvement Program. We have re-applied for NIP for the next fiscal year and will know by mid-Aug. if we may distribute credits from Sept. '07 to June '08.
- *LED grant:* AOI was awarded a \$3,500 Local Economic Development Assistance Grant to be used to purchase a permanent and tangible item for the organization.
- *Corporate aid:* Walmart in Moundsville gave us \$500 to educate the public about service opportunities AOI provides the community.
- *Other potential funds:* We are one of four finalists for the Community Service Block Grant funds from the WV State Development Office.
