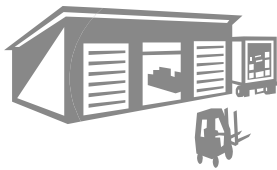

## NIP Vouchers Again Available

For the fourth year in a row AOI has been allocated tax credits by the State of West Virginia through its Neighborhood Investment Program (NIP). From August 2009 through June 30, 2010, we have been allocated \$4,980,

and we still have \$3,900 to give.

Credits are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Individuals or businesses donating at least \$500 to AOI can receive up to 50% of that dona-

tion back as a tax credit. Individuals who itemize donations on their federal income tax return may also qualify for additional federal tax savings.

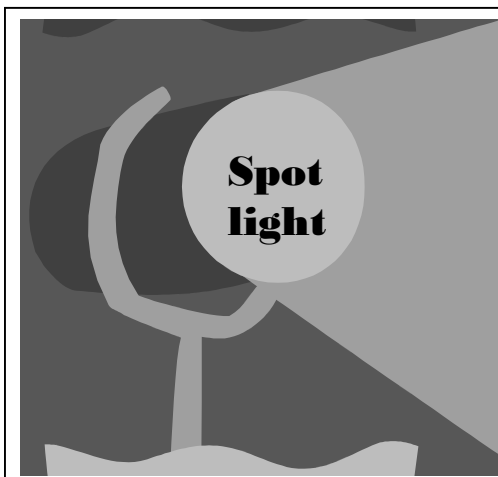
