This year's tax credits are earmarked for donations supporting purchase of the new truck, insurance, maintenance, and delivery expenses. We still have \$9,700 in tax credits available.

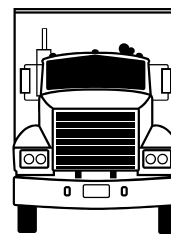
New Truck Update

We are only \$5,000 and a few months from receiving our new truck, a 2014 Hino, through Matheny Motors.

The truck is ordered and in production with an expected delivery

date of mid-November. It will then be lettered and is expected ready for duty by the start of December.

We have now raised \$80,000, and



need to reach \$85,000 for a cash deal. If you would like to donate, mark checks "truck fund." Donations of \$500 or more are eligible for NIP tax credits.

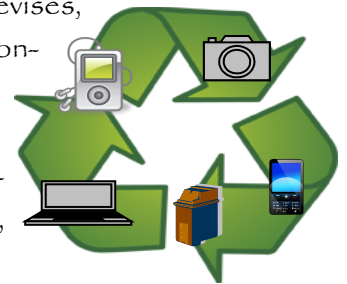
AOI says "Thanks"
