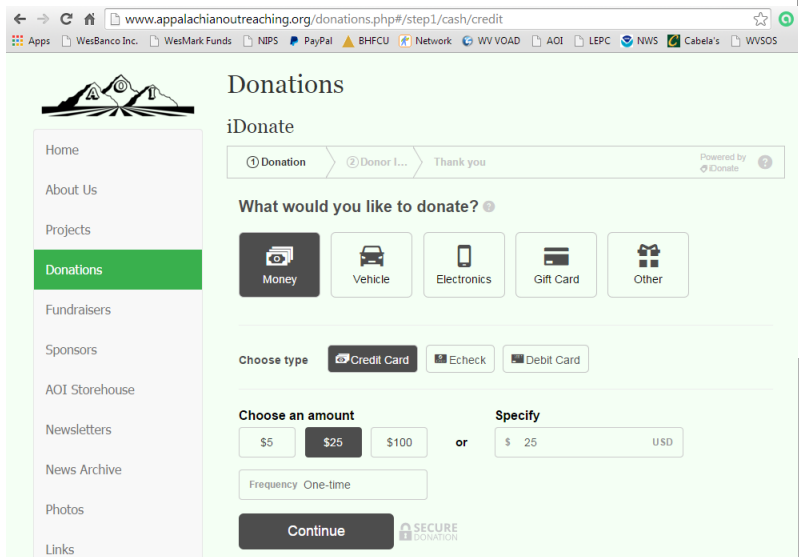

Get a head start on your taxes for 2015. The West Virginia Development Office has once again awarded AOI \$10,000 in tax credits through the Neighborhood Investment Program (NIP). Tax credits can be re-

ceived for donations of \$500 or more, and will be given on a first come, first served basis. We still have \$5,100 in tax credits available.

Have you ever considered...

...sponsoring a trip for delivery?

To cover the full cost of delivery (including maintenance, insurance, licensing, tolls, truck weighing, fuel, meals for volunteer drivers), AOI must increase our delivery fee from 1 to 2.5 cents per pound. This will increase the burden on our network partners, some of whom have few financial resources. Manna from Heaven, for instance, our partner in Myra, KY, our furthest trip, will pay over \$525 for each delivery in 2015, up nearly \$140 per delivery from last year. These agencies can use your help.

Please consider sponsoring a delivery trip. You may do so as an individual or a group. Make checks payable to AOI and put "delivery" in the memo.

Baby Baskets help needed

Our Baby Basket project runs year-round. We need donations of baby products to help fill the baskets, especially one-sies. Last year we delivered 642 to young mothers in need!

We will soon gear up for our CHRISTmas Gift Project. Last 10,787 elderly and disable adults received a gift. Thanks to a grant from the Christian Foundation we have been able to add Bibles to both these projects.



This issue, a special thank you to our delivery drivers: Deak Hores, Ray Stucke, Terry Grimes, Diane Reineke. Together they drove 25,552 miles in 2014, making 52 trips, delivering over 172 tons of goods to our neighbors in need.
