Persons living in poverty have no means to acquire items such as bath soap, shampoo, toothpaste/ tooth brushes , shaving cream and other such items.

Maybe you are not aware that the Department of Agriculture oversees the food stamp program. Personal care items and cleaning items are not part of the service they offer.

Young ladies and women often don't have the income to purchase

feminine hygiene items. This leads to missed school and work days.

To help with some of these needs, AOI is collecting these items. There is a special fund set up for the purchase of items. It is our goal to send a box or several boxes with each delivery we make throughout the year. This will enable our contact people in each county to add items to food baskets or to give out as needed.

If you travel and have small

size shampoo, conditioner, soap or lotion, these are also acceptable to help fill the need.

Another need is for such things as toilet paper, paper towels , laundry detergent and other cleaning supplies.

Items can be dropped off at the warehouse or mailed to AOI.



Announcing: A Growing Partnership

West Virginia State Parks and AOI have entered into a partnership for the recycling of soaps from the lodge rooms. Containers have been placed in each room for guests to put their leftover soap when they are leaving. This soap is sent to Wild Mountain Soaps in Fayetteville WV. They are sanitized and

repackaged, then sent to AOI for distribution.

Several State Park Cabins are being refurbished. The furniture has been given to AOI for distribution in several counties that AOI serves.

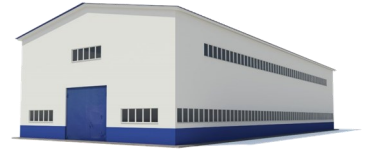
Tax Credits are Here

The West Virginia Development Office has awarded AOI \$9,500.00 in Neighborhood Investment Tax Credits.

In the application we stipulated that any donations received would be used to expand our outreach to two new areas in WV, pay for insurance for our 2 trucks, help to pay 2 people to work in the warehouse and do local pick ups two days per week. Donations of \$500.00 or more are required to receive tax credits. When an donation is received, a voucher worth 50% of the donation will be issued to the donor as well as a donations receipt for use with their income tax return. Tax credits are given on a first come, first served basis from now until June 30, 2020.

Capital Campaign continues...

It's a dire necessity that we continue to plan for a permanent home in order that we can better serve our neighbors in need locally and statewide. And it is a hardship on our volunteers and staff to work in an unheated facility. Our goal is to raise \$500,000. Funding will be used for purchase of land or a building, remodeling or construction. We are researching ways to be energy efficient and economical.
