NIPS TAX CREDITS ARE HERE

We are pleased to announce that AOI has been awarded \$16,000 in NIPS (Neighborhood Investment Tax Credits). This is the 15th straight year that AOI has received credits. The credits are available for both businesses and personal use. Cash, personal property and stocks are acceptable. Donations must be at least \$500.00. After

receiving the donation, AOI will send a voucher to the donor worth 50% of the donated amount. This can be used to offset up to 50% of one's state tax liability. Credits may be carried over up to five years.

AOI will use NIPS donations to procure personal care items, cleaning supplies and underwear for low income

people in Ohio / Marshall Counties. Networking with other organizations will help to spread the items to more people. in these areas Tax credits are on a first come- first served basis. Donations can be mailed to AOI at P.O. Box 233, Glen Dale WV 26038.

20 Years and counting!

AOI is celebrating their 20th anniversary this year. The WV floods in July 2001 started the process to build AOI when we asked ourselves what we could do for those who needed so much help in our own state. The first collection was held in August. It brought in 46 tons of furniture, housewares, bedding, etc. This load was delivered to Wyoming County on 9-12-2001. \$6,000. was also donated which helped to buy items like electric heaters and tools for those rebuilding. Another 40 tons was donated that fall. When we asked ourselves what was God trying to tell us, the word was “GO”, make this a nonprofit to serve victims of poverty and disaster in WV and surrounding areas. In the 20 years AOI has delivered to 46 WV counties and 60 areas plus 2 in KY as well as serving our local area.
